- Age Range: two's
- Lesson Domain: Cognitive Development
- Lesson Objective: To help how the child thinks, explores, and figures things out



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DEVELOPMENTAL GOAL

- Lesson Objective: Cognitive Development
- What are we trying to accomplish?
 - We are helping the child to think about what shape each object is and sorting them into the correct shape taped on the floor.



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MATERIALS

- Here is what you need:
 - Painters tape
 - Different objects around the house of different shapes
 - EX: square- crackers, triangle-toy, rectangle-books, circles-balls, oval-egg



METHOD

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- Here is what to do:
 - You will create a shape out of painter's tape on the floor big enough to fit small objects inside
 - Example:
 - Circle: cookie, ball, orange
 - Square: dice, book, blocks
 - Oval: balloon, eggs, football
 - Rectangle: blocks, cards, books
 - Triangle: blocks, sails, toys
